

ENDOW MARYLAND TAX CREDIT

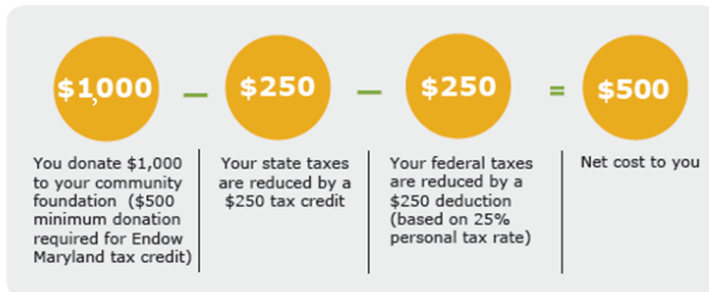
A Maryland state tax credit called “**Endow Maryland**” rewards donors who help build permanent charitable funds for local communities across the state and right here in Anne Arundel County. Endow Maryland offers a tax credit for gifts from \$500 - \$20,000 to permanent, endowed funds at qualified community foundations in Maryland.

Community Benefit

Endow Maryland provides an incentive for Marylanders to give back to their local communities in a meaningful and lasting way. It promotes philanthropic giving in Maryland, for Maryland.

Endow Maryland tax credits can be used to support permanent charitable funds at the Community Foundation of Anne Arundel County (CFAAC) funds that allow us to address Anne Arundel County's greatest needs today and for generations to come. Your gifts to establish or add to an existing endowed fund at CFAAC may qualify for a 25% tax credit on your 2016 tax return. CFAAC has \$15,000 available to offer to donors on a first-come, first-served basis.

How to make a \$1,000 donation cost only \$500*



Permanence

The Endow Maryland tax credit applies only to gifts to permanent, endowed funds at qualified Maryland community foundations. These gifts will generate many times the initial value of the gift in benefit of Anne Arundel County forever.
